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OVERVIEW

Run cloud labs on a department budget, with cost controls that hold.

Cloud labs fail for two reasons: nobody owns the account, and nobody caps the spend. Both are solvable in three days.

Module 1 — Accounts, identity and guardrails (6h recommended)

Theory: Organisations, roles, least privilege, student accounts

Lab: Build a locked-down lab account

Output: Lab account with policies applied

Module 2 — The lab stack (6h recommended)

Theory: Compute, storage, networking and databases as students will meet them

Lab: Provision and tear down a full lab environment

Output: Reusable lab template

Module 3 — Cost control and operations (6h recommended)

Theory: Budgets, alerts, scheduled shutdown, quotas

Lab: Set budgets and trigger an alert deliberately

Output: Budget and alert configuration
