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OVERVIEW

Students deliver clear, confident talks and handle themselves on camera and in interviews.

Communication ability shapes every career; graduates who speak well and hold a media presence gain an advantage in placements and in public-facing roles.

Output: Recorded piece

Module 4 — Capstone (4h recommended)

Theory: A recorded talk and a mock interview

Lab: Deliver a talk and a mock interview

Output: Recorded talk and interview
